It was also the second highest-grossing film of 2001 in the U.S. and worldwide (behind *Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone*). It won four Academy Awards and five BAFTAs, including Best Film and Best Director. The cast wore a total of 19,000 specially made costumes. In 2007, *The Fellowship of the Ring* was voted number 50 on the American Film Institute's list of 100 greatest American films. The AFI also voted it the second greatest fantasy film of all time.
